A Safety Drive for 15 days is to be launched from 27.01.2025 to 10.02.2025, to check drunkenness on duty of railway officials. All officers and Supervisors are requested to give special emphasis on the following aspects: -

- i. Random ambush checks must be conducted by Officers/Inspectors/Supervisors with portable breathalyzer at stations en-route to check whether Staff are not under the influence of alcohol.
- ii. All Inspectors/Supervisors should be advised to take feedback from different sources and maintain a list of Staff working under them who are habitual of drinking occasionally/regularly.
- iii. List of such Staff prone to alcohol should be available in with Officers/Inspectors/Supervisors irrespective of group.
- iv. A special watch should be kept on these alcoholic Staff.
- v. All the staff should be counseled that it is their moral duty to report in case any Staff is found under the influence of alcohol.
- vi. Staff identified as alcoholic should be counseled on short term/long term ill effects of alcohol during trainings.
- vii. All Inspectors/Supervisors must be provided with portable breathalyzers for conducting surprise checks and they should carry the same when they go on inspection on line.
- viii. Families of Staff should also be counseled on the ill effects of the alcohol.
  - ix. Alcoholic staff should be sent for de-addiction camps.
  - x. De-addiction camps may be organized by Concern BO's Divisions within their resources or alternatively NGOs should be identified for the purpose. These camps should be organized at regular intervals and this should be a continuous process.

All running staff (LP, ALP and TM), train passing staff/control staff and maintenance staff while on duty must be covered during this drive. Officers of DLI Division should also involved themselves to this drive.

Effective follow up action should be taken on all deficiencies and irregularities during the drive, Compliance cum affirmation report of drive with irregularities and remedial action taken should be sent to this office by 11.02.2025 positively for further submission to HQ Office.

Officers of departments from HQ should also be involved. PCSOs to critically analyze such cases and ensure effective actions are taken as per rule. Action taken should be sent to the Board by 10.02.2025.
